The Mobile Crisis Management Team is a field-based program comprised of a Clinical Therapist, Behavioral Health Specialist II, Behavioral Health Specialist III and a Peer Support Specialist. This team specializes in crisis intervention, housing resources and supports, substance use services and supports and peer support. The team works collaboratively with community agencies to find solutions for homelessness and substance use as well as providing services including outreach and referral for the mental health and substance use needs of individuals within the community.

Program Goals

- Provide immediate crisis intervention services in the community for individuals who may be in need of mental and behavioral health support.
- Assess individuals based on their own unique challenges with homelessness, substance use, and mental health needs.
- Provide Peer Support Services, which will link individuals/families to community resources and recovery services and aid in minimizing barriers to those resources.
- Decrease the number of contacts Law Enforcement/Emergency Departments have with individuals by de-escalating a potential crisis.
- Provide short-term therapy, substance use counseling, and case management services to individuals and their families with linkage to long-term services.
- Provide linkage, advocacy and support to the community to enhance and maintain an optimal level of healthy personal and social functioning.

We Serve

- Members of the community in surrounding areas who are experiencing a mental health, housing, or substance use crisis of any age.
- Individuals with or without Medi-Cal insurance.
- Clinic walk-ins welcome
