OPIOID OVERDOSE TRAINING

Learn how to recognize signs of an overdose, the steps to administering Naloxone, and how to save a life!

What is **Naloxone**?

Naloxone is a medication designed to rapidly reverse opioid overdose.

The training will help those who participate understand the signs of when someone is potentially overdosing. The training further goes into the steps necessary to safely stabilize an overdose victim until first responders arrive. Participants will have the opportunity to receive a Naloxone kit after completion.

Opioid Effects in 2021

Opioid-related overdoses resulted in 769 deaths in Riverside County in 2021. Knowing how to properly respond to an overdose can help save a life. Naloxone Narcan nasal spray is a safe and effective medication that can quickly reverse an opioid overdose. A two-dose pack of Narcan will be available to the trainees following the training.
